Property Tax Deductions

A \$250 deduction is available for qualified
veterans or a surviving spouse of a veteran.
Disabled veterans or surviving spouse may be
entitled to full exemption from property taxes.

Farmland Preservation

Approaches 10,000 Acres

With recent settlements of the Charlie
Joyce and Andy Thomas farms, Upper
Pittsgrove's preserved farm acreage is
now at 8,614 acres. There are 15 more
farms approved with funding in place
that will soon bring another 1,277 acres
for a total of 9,891 acres helping Upper
Pittsgrove continue to be number one of
the 566 municipalities in New Jersey.

Preserved farms help maintain our rural
quality of life by reducing pollution, traf-
fic, and crime and by providing scenic
vistas and recreational opportunities like
bicycling, hiking and hunting. They also
help keep taxes lower since farms use
in municipal services only 30 cents of
every dollar they pay in taxes making
them excellent ratables.

New Jersey already has the highest
property taxes in the United States. In
Salem County, we have the opportunity
to protect what's special about this area
before it's too late. For any landowners

THIS SERVICE IS LIMITED TO RESIDENTIAL IN APRIL AND OCTOBER ONLY !!!

To be placed on the schedule call 358-0466 and leave a message with your name and address.

Service will be provided for normal, seasonal trimming of trees and shrubs. Brush **MUST BE** placed with cut ends to the edge of the road.

In event of a severe storm, brush and limbs may be chipped at the discretion of the Public Works Department.

Construction Debris
