

ORDINANCE 2012-2

“AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE COMPENSATION TO BE PAID TO THE ELECTED AND APPOINTED OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF UPPER PITTSBORO”

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Upper Pittsgrove in the County of Salem and the state of New Jersey, that:

1. Such ordinance fixing the compensation to be paid to the elected and appointed officers and employees of the Township of Upper Pittsgrove be amended as follows:

4. This Ordinance shall take effect and become operative as of January 1, 2012, upon its final passage and publication as required by law and the provisions of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect until amended or repealed.
